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- Make a small loop in the end of the rope.
- Cross the left rope over the right rope and bring it under the loop.

- Tie an overhand knot in the other rope.
- Pass the first rope through the loop of the second overhand knot.
- Tighten both knots.

- Flip the knot over and tighten again.

- Pass the end of the other rope through the loop of the figure-eight knot.
- Tie a figure-eight knot in the other rope.
- Pass the first rope through the loop of the second figure-eight knot.
- Tighten both knots.

Steps:

- Cross the left rope over the right rope.

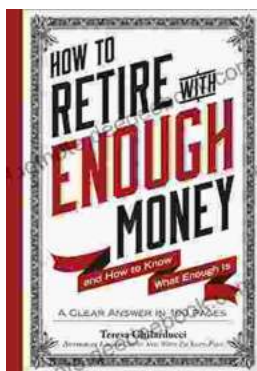
- Bring the left rope under the right rope and up through the loop.

- Tighten the knot by pulling on both ends of the rope.



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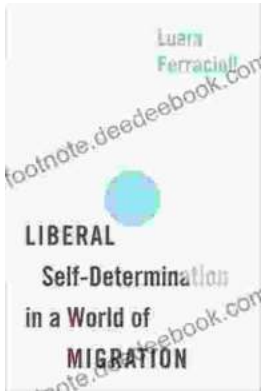
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
