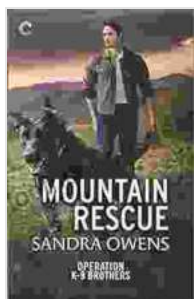


Mountain Rescue Operation Brothers: A Story of Courage and Perseverance

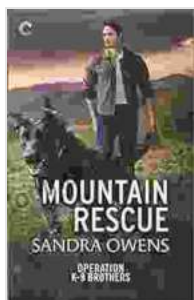

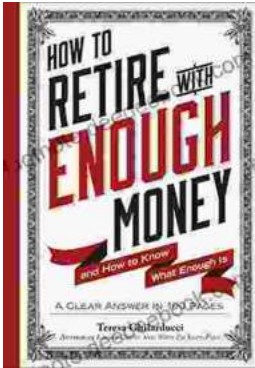
