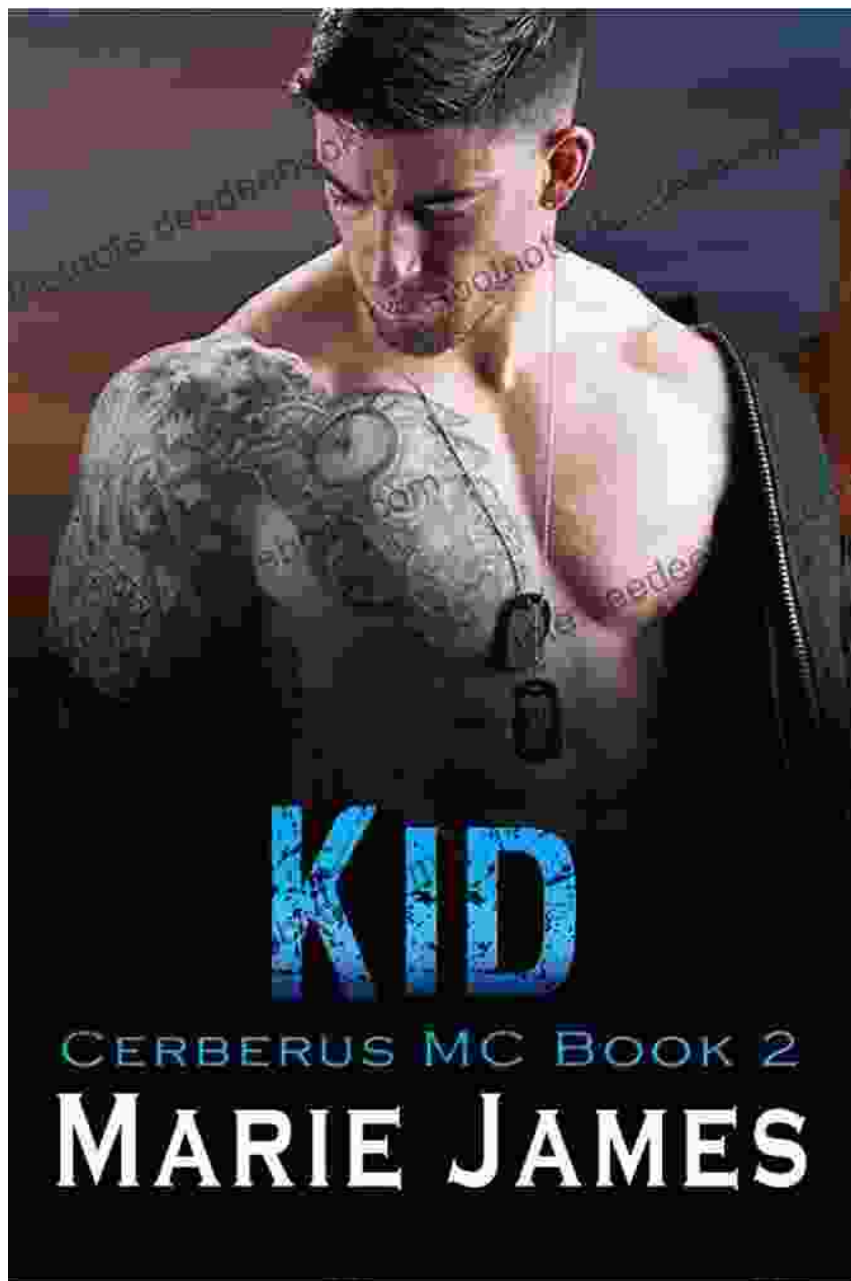


Cerberus Mc 13 live performance

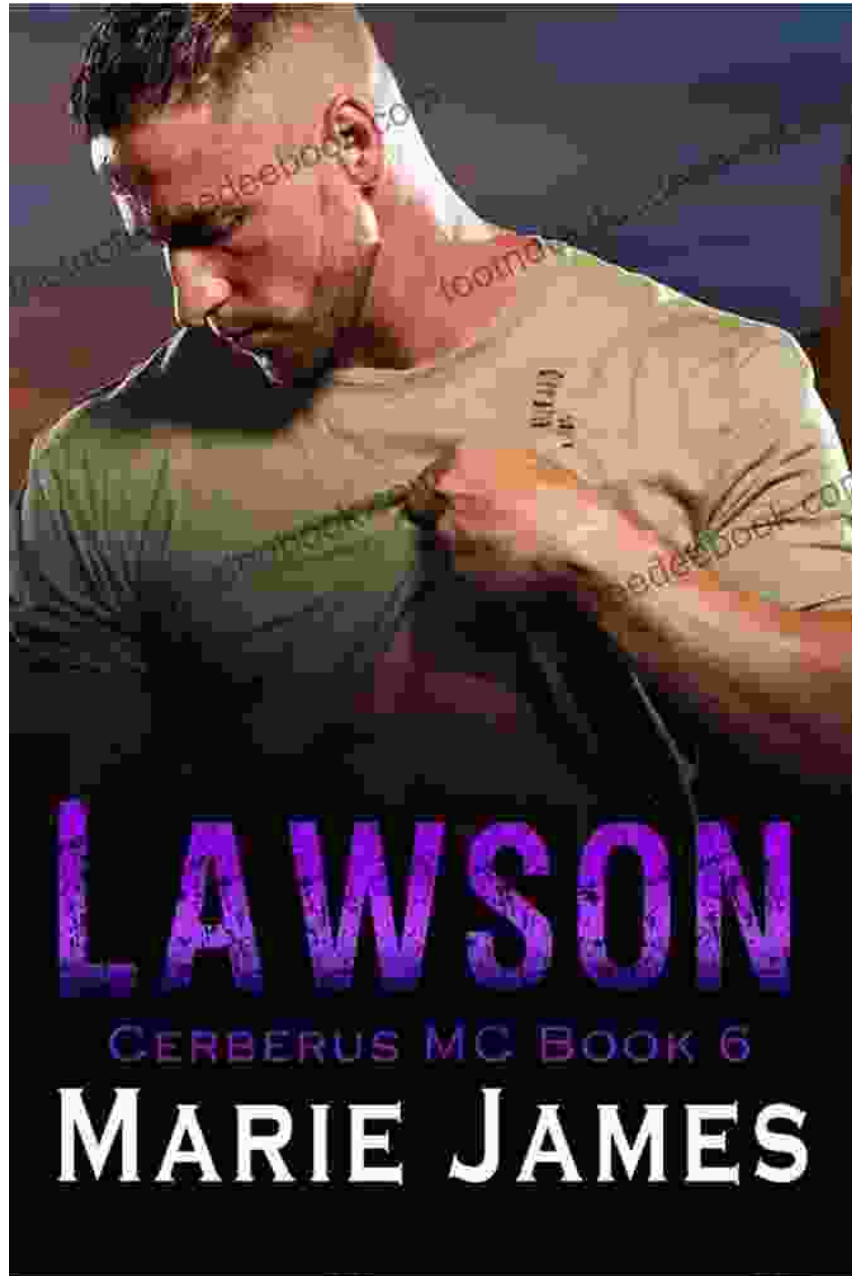


Marie James in her later years

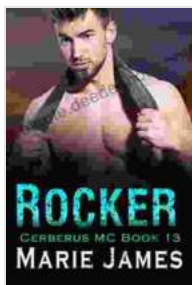

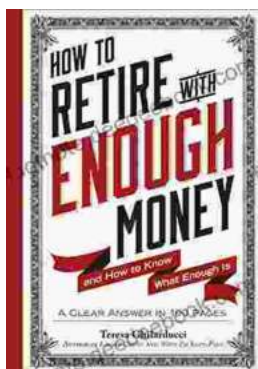
