Simple Crochet Patterns for Beginners

1. Easy Granny Square

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Work 3 sc into the ring.
- 3. Ch 2 and turn.

- 4. 2 sc in the first st, *ch 2, 3 sc in the next st, repeat from * around.
- 5. Ch 2 and turn.
- 6. In each corner space, work 3 sc, ch 2, 3 sc.
- 7. Repeat steps 5-6 until desired size is reached.

2. Simple Scarf

- 1. Ch to desired length (e.g., 50-75).
- 2. Work sc across each row.
- 3. Continue until desired width is reached.

3. Beginner's Blanket

- 1. Ch to desired length (e.g., 100-150).
- 2. Work 2 hdc in the first ch, *hdc in the next ch, repeat from * across.
- 3. Ch 2 and turn.
- 4. Work 2 hdc in the first hdc, *hdc in each hdc across, repeat from *.
- 5. Repeat steps 3-4 until desired width is reached.

Tips for Beginners

- Use a light-colored yarn to make it easier to see your stitches.
- Hold the hook and yarn comfortably, avoiding tension in your hands.
- Count your stitches regularly to ensure accuracy.




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
